The program has theory classes that covers the principles of film making including story telling, pre-production, production, post-production and distribution. The program, also, complements theory with practical activities to make great movies and to gain experience hands-on the whole process. The instructors have full experience in story-telling, cinematography, composition, film making, editing, color-grading and photography. The studio has won film-festivals awards including "Best Original Story" feature category from the L.A. Film Festival in Los Angeles CA U.S.A., "Best Producer" feature category from the UNIVERSAL Film Festival in Kansas City. MO U.S.A., "Best Sci-Fi/Fantasy" feature category from the Alternative Film Festival in Toronto, ON Canada among others.

About the students, the program is for teens (boys and girls) ages 11 to 16 that in addition to learn the art of film making, they are looking into improve their English language. The classes are in English, with additional tutoring classes two days a week. Other days will be after school activities for the students.

The program is a summer school camp for international visitors. No need to get a student visa. A visitor visa is enough to enroll for this film making summer camp.



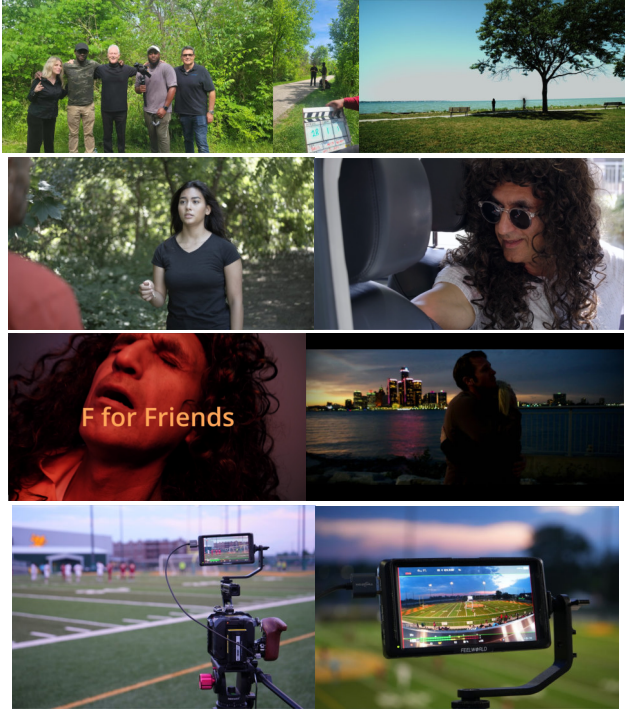

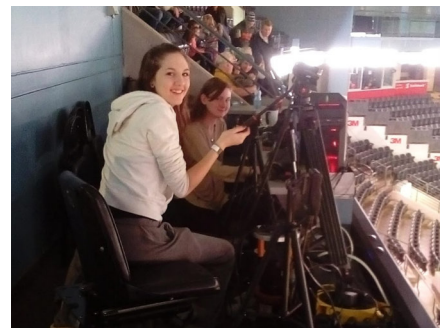

Students will learn to create great stories, direct, film and edit their own movies. In groups of five they will practice not only film making techniques but also how to interact on set.

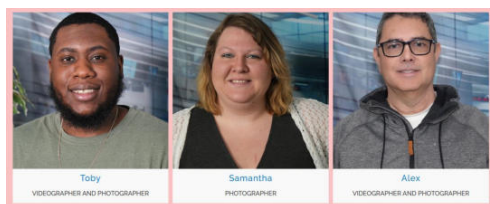
